

**March 28, 2015
Annual Meeting**

The Otsego Township Annual Meeting was called to order on Saturday, March 28, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. with 16 residents present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Minutes were read from the 2014 annual meeting. Motion by Gale Dugan and supported by Tom Burns to approve the minutes as read. Motion carried.

Supervisor's Salary – Motion by Tom Burns and supported by Gale Dugan to approve the 1.6% raise for the supervisor as approved in the February board resolution for the amount of \$18,828.56. 9 yes, 0 no. Motion carried.

Clerk's salary – Motion by tom Burns and supported by Chuck Cushman to approve the 1.6% raise for the clerk as approved in the February board resolution for the amount of \$28,972.23. 9 yes, 1 no. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Salary – Motion by Gale Dugan and supported by tom Burns to approve the 1.6% raise for the treasurer as approved in the February board resolution for the amount of \$28,972.23. 9 yes, 1 no. Motion carried.

Trustee's salary - Motion by Tom Burns and supported by Chuck Cushman to approve the 1.6% raise for the trustee's as approved in the February board resolution for the amount of \$2,422.09. 9 yes, 1 no. Motion carried.

Supervisor's Report: The water tower has been painted. The road counts were done after the millage passed. The millage passed was 1.5 mils. Jefferson Road had a high count. The Konos Egg Farm in the northwest portion of the county has been approved. Prairiewood Golf Course has been purchased by the DeYoung farm. The new fire truck arrived in February. The truck being replaced was in an accident and we received \$22,000 for the fire equipment. We held the August 2014 tire recycling event. Another one will be held on August 1, 2015. Bryan relayed a bid thank you to all the staff, clerk, treasurer, sexton, board of review, planning commission, ZBA etc. for all the hard work they have done this year.

Open forum: Mike Bumgart asked about the fire department and if we will be blindsided again on what is needed in way of repairs.

Lynn Morrell would like to see the board say what roads need to be fixed and not the county dictating. A fire year plan is needed and will be done at the April meeting.

It was requested that the web site be updated more often.

Lori Bumgart asked if the Supervisor position is requiring it be more of a full time position. Bryan said that not at this point is it merited.
