

**March 26, 2016
Annual Meeting**

The Otsego Township Annual meeting was held on Saturday, March 26, 2016 at the Otsego Township Hall. The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. with 13 residents present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

The minutes from the 2015 annual meeting were read by Clerk Hunt. Motion by Joan Squibbs and supported by Tom Burns to approve the minutes as read.

New Business: Salaries – The February resolutions presented the Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer, and Trustees with no raise.

Motion by Tom Burns to approve the resolutions as stated with no raises for the board.

Mike Bumgart made a motion to increase all the salaries by 1.5% because we have done all that was said would be done. There was no support for this motion so the motion failed.

Karen Burns supported Tom's motion for no raises. 8 yes, 1 no. Motion carried.

Supervisor's report: Jefferson Rd. was paved this year with the erosion problem being taken of. The lift station was painted. The egg farm is in progress. A gas line was put in on 22nd ST. to the farm.

Open forum: Lynn Morrell stated that the city is asking for 2 mills for public safety millage in May. The Township may do a public safety millage in August. Lynn had talked to Jon Campbell and he said he wants to have the gravel roads graded.
